- 1 3 Step on L ft behind R ft.
 - 2 Bounce on L ft.
- 4 1 Step on R ft.

PART 2.

Repeat meas 1-2 of Part 1.

- "Pas-des-Basque"
- 1 Step (fall) on L ft. &
- Step on R ft next to L toes. 2 Step (fall) on L ft in place.
- Repeat meas 4 of Part 1.

Note: Part 1 and Part 2 are alternated to the musical phrases in the accompaniment.

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
