## PATRUNINO -- Macedonia (Aegean) (Line dance, no ptrs)

Translation: Patruna is a girl's name.

Rhythm: 11/16 (d. 600) counted 1-and-ah (d.), 2-and-3-

and (d), 4-and-5-and (d).

Starting Position: "T" position. R ft free.

Music 11/16 Measure

Facing slightly and moving R, hop on R ft (ct 1), Step fwd on L ft (cts 2, 3), Turning to face ctr, close and step on R ft beside L (cts 4, 5).

Hop on R ft, swinging L ft fwd (ct 1), Hop again on R ft, bending L knee to bring L ft under body (cts 2, 3). Close and step on L ft in place beside R (cts 4, 5).

Hop on L ft, swinging R ft fwd (ct 1), Hop again on L ft, bending R knee to bring R ft under body (cts 2, 3), Turning to face slightly and moving R, step fwd on R ft (cts 4, 5).

Note: Dancers generally begin on cts 4,5 of meas 3.
