Step fwd on L (ct_1); lift on L raising R behind L calf (cts 2,3). Repeat action of meas 1-3, 3 more times (4 in all).

Includes 16 meas of vocal, plus 8 meas of orchestra.

Moving RLOD, walk R,L,R,L-R (the L-R represents a quick change).

Walk L,R,L,R-L (the R-L is done in place. A step on the R, and a stop with a bounce may be substituted). On second L begin moving slightly up (fwd). The next 2 meas move in the form of

a triangle.

Moving diag L, walk R,L,R,L-R (or L-stop bounce).

Moving diag bkwd and slightly L, walk L,R,L,R-L (or R-

stop bounce).
