Rhythm: 9/16 meter: 1,2-1,2-1,2,-1,-1,2. Slow-Slow-Slow-Quick-Slow.

Formation: Line.

| 1 | Part II Facing ctr, step on R to R, step L behind R, in place step on R in front of L, small bounce onto L in back of R, touch R in place (no wt). |

There is no sequence to the dance. The leader signals the changes. The clarinet solo is usually considered a good

place for the change.
